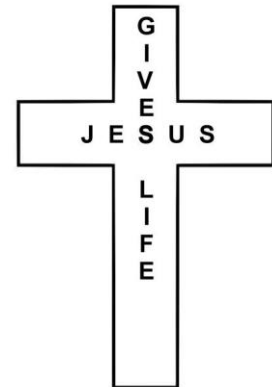


LEVEL BLUE: LESSON 1

- If we believe in Him and trust Him we will be saved from our sins and have eternal life.

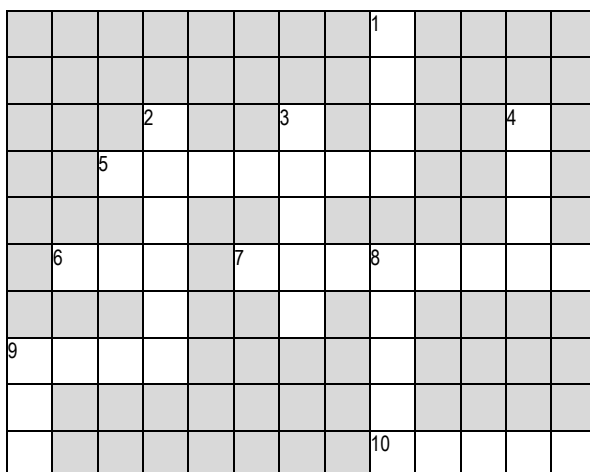
