Pastor Jordan met hundreds of people in Bangladesh who have received the Gospels. He met people doing the correspondence course and young people who had converted to Christianity and had been baptized. On one occasion he was with a team of Christians and a journalist came alongside on a motorcycle and urged him not to go any further because as a foreigner his life would be in great danger.

There are many troubled parts of the world where Christians are persecuted and sometimes executed. But for all this opposition and hostility, the Christian gospel is going out and there are people becoming believers and the church is growing. A further 50,000 Gospels of John will be printed for Bangladesh, sponsored by TPTL Australia, for 2020.

Speaking at a 20,000-member church in Bogota, Colombia (South America). 5,500 Gospels were given to people to share with others over the coming weeks and tell them about John 3:16. TPTL Latin America is wanting to expand into the city and open a ministry centre.



After travelling for three and a half days by bus and boat ride we finally arrived on the edge of the jungle. 10km away there is a tribe that is still known to poison visitors. People of the church in the jungle that we visited were very depressed because they were ashamed that they had such poor facilities. There were no showers, no toilet, and no electricity.

A pastor and his wife are willing to begin ministry in the Amazon beginning in 2020. They need a motorboat to visit remote areas.
