Ministry to the Bible College students in Jakarta. These students will go to the various islands of Indonesia as Christian teachers, pastors and church leaders. They will still have to deal with many challenges in primitive conditions and be confronted by sorcery and witchcraft. The students also visit the prisons of Jakarta and see conversions to Christ from Muslims.



"Last week we give the tracts and gospel of John to the criminal prison in Jakarta. We are doing the services and share the God's Word there. And then after lunch we have some correspondence and about 112 inmates want to have a new life (repent) and praise the Lord! Some of them is ask for baptism.

Actually most of them was new member in prison. And when we are sharing and hear some stories one to another, most of them has divorce and also the wife left them because they are coming to prison. And they can't communicate with their family especially with their children. It really touched us.

Please keep pray for us to always give the spirit for the people that need God and looking for God in their life.

And some tracts & gospel of John was given in some province in Indonesia like Mentawai, North Sumatra, Nias Island, Flores, etc. Because of the limitations of the area and conditions, we can't get the picture and also blurred like in prison we can take a picture there and can't bring camera or mobile phone inside." Hello dear brethren and TPTL Board members in Australia.

Here there are some photos of evangelism in Venezuela. And in the border with Colombia in the City of Cucuta. Daily 7,000 people crosses the line to Colombia running away from the dictatorial government in Venezuela. The lack of water, food, medical care, and no electricity in 92% of the country is making worse everyday the survival in Venezuela. So they decide to go to other countries in a really bad situation. Most of the ladies and girls under 15 years old are going into prostitution or drug dealers to get some money for their families and children. Many children are being abused in Colombia, Ecuador and Peru, they sell literally the children for hours to get something to eat. Also, many children are disappeared and until today police is looking for them for weeks. We are getting to all these people in disgrace. We preach to them and share the gospel. In the photos you may see many family members in the situation described above. But today they are on hope. The Gospel and the discipleship plus some humanitarian help we get for them are making the difference.
