SOUTH AMERICA - 100,000 GOSPELS

Through your generous giving 100,000 gospels are presently being printed and will be distributed throughout Colombia and other countries in Latin America in the coming months and year.

Additionally, through a generous supporter, money has been sent to support a pastor to minister in the Amazon Jungle.

Recently, a group of three evangelists from TPTL Latin America, were sent to a city in Colombia to preach the gospel, share gospels of John with people, and provide gospels of John to churches for ongoing outreach. During their time there, believers in churches were trained in evangelism, many gospels were given out, and a number of people put their faith in Jesus as their Saviour and Lord.

Other outreaches have taken place in different places throughout Colombia, Venezuela and Peru where gospels were given out in parks, prisons, streets, bus stations and buses.

As a result of TPTL evangelist efforts throughout Colombia, a number of new house churches have been planted and Christians are being discipled and trained in how to share their faith. One such new house church is in the town of Malambo, Colombia where fifteen new converts are meeting to worship the Lord and be discipled.

The work of TPTL in Colombia, by God's grace, is having a great impact through the country and other Latin American countries. Thank you for your partnership in making this possible.

THAILAND - GOSPEL IS PREACHED TO THOUSANDS

Thousands of people have been reached in the past six months with the gospel through outreaches conducted in schools, prisons, market places, villages and churches all throughout Thailand by Somchai and TPTL volunteer evangelists and helpers.

One such area they traveled to for outreach and discipleship was in the North of Thailand, on the Myanmar/Thai Border. They traveled there to minister amongst the Karen people who mostly live in huts in villages in the hills. Even though Somchai has been to this area many times in the past, it still can be dangerous and his life can be threatened by those who strongly oppose the gospel being preached. Praise God that on this trip all went well and he did not encounter any problems or people trying to kill him for preaching the gospel.

In another recent outreach meeting, Somchai reports that he was able to personally lead Mrs Jumbta Somboonchai and her husband to faith in Jesus Christ which was a cause of great blessing to him. Please pray that these new converts would grow in Jesus and be a faithful witness to their family members and others around them.

Each week they send out over 300 correspondence courses, predominantly to those who are in prison, but also to both children and adults in the community throughout Thailand.

TPTL Australia has been financially supporting Somchai and his wife for nearly 40 years. They have been and still are faithful servants of the Lord who are doing a great job. However, there is a great shortfall in financial support that is needed in order to continue to support them financially to carry out this work.
