## SOUTH AMERICA

Evangelism is up and running again in South America. Many volunteers have been going out to preach the gospel to the people in hospitals, streets and jails. We have reached four new cities and we plan to reach four new ones this month.

We are organising crusades for outreach in Colombia, Peru, Venezuela and Ecuador. Due to the hard times we are living in, many people are hungry for the gospel and we are facing a great revival here in South America.

We have doubled up the volunteers, evangelists and missionaries willing to preach and go forth to make disciples. We have distributed 75,000 gospels in 2020.

Pastor Jairo is currently travelling throughout the Amazon where he is meeting with 150 pastors for training. This training will equip the pastors to go out and preach the gospel to the tribes throughout the jungle. He will be there for six months, returning end of July. Please pray for him as he does ministry in the Amazon.

## NIGERIA

In January we visited Ekiebong village where we had revival meetings in the evening and did outreach during the day. Through the preaching of the gospel of the kingdom of God, four young men believed in Christ and also joined our local church in the village.

The man in the picture was struck by an evil spirit of death, but the Lord Jesus used one of our trained disciples who is pastoring a local church in the village to bring him back to life. He has made a bondservant commitment to be discipled so that he can preach the good news of our common salvation in Christ Jesus. I gave a copy of the gospel of John to him and the three other men and encouraged them to read it every day this month while they wait for God's provision for them to get their own copies of the Holy Bible. Please remember these young men in prayer as I start discipleship teaching with them.

I will be shortly embarking on a mission trip to Obundu and Ikom in Cross River. I will be distributing some gospels to Pastors in this area.

Continue to hold me and my discipleship team up in your daily prayer. We have more villages to visit in order to minister the gospel of Christ to the villagers who are living in fear of witchcraft and idols. The goal is evangelism, Discipleship, training and sending.
